# SCHEDULE OF PROCEEDINGS

- 1** 0930am Parade commences from Broadwater Avenue Carpark, Airlie Beach
- 2** 0935am 3CER halted by Senior Police Officer and challenged; scroll recited by Commanding Officer; 3CER granted access to continue march
- 3** 0940am 3CER commences march past Airlie Beach Cenotaph and conducts a salute on the march
- 4** 0945am 3CER halted on Ocean Road, parade dismissed and moves to number 6 location
- 5** 0945am At completion of the march past, Mayor Collins and dignitaries will move along selected path to the Mayor address to 3CER and community members at number 6 location
- 6** 1010am 3CER located at Mayor address location
- 7** 1040am Parade complete, capability display and community event commences
